Description	The protein encoded by this gene was previously thought to support proliferation of lymphoid cells and was considered an interleukin. However, this activity has not been reproducible and the function of this protein is currently unknown. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008].
Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µ filtered solution of PBS,pH 7.4
Molecular Mass	18kD
Purity	>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Concentration	Always centrifuge tubes before opening. Do not mix by vortex or pipetting. It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than 100 µg/ml. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in 1X PBS. Please aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.
