Product Overview	Recombinant human ZFP37 protein, fused to His tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E. coli.

Description	This gene encodes a transcription factor that belongs to a large family of zinc finger proteins. A similar protein in mouse is thought to play a role in regulating the structures of the nucleolus and centromere in neurons. Alternate splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided by RefSeq, Sep 2013].
Form	25 mM Tris, pH 8.0, 150 mM NaCl, 10 % glycerol, 1 % Sarkosyl. Store at -80 centigrade. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. Stable for at least 3 months from receipt of products under proper storage and handling conditions.

Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Concentration	>50 ug/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
