

Active Recombinant Human Lectin, Galactoside-Binding, Soluble, 1

SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	A DNA sequence encoding the human LGALS1 (Met 1-Asp135) was expressed. The recombinant human LGALS1 comprises 134 amino acids and migrates as an approximately 15 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions as predicted.

Description	LGALS1, the first identified member of the β -galactoside-binding animal lectin family, and exists as a homodimer of a single carbohydrate-recognition domain. LGALS1 is expressed in a variety of cell types, including thymic epithelial cells, endothelial cells, dendritic cells, macrophages, fibroblasts, and bone marrow stromal cells. There is increased galectin-1 expression in many types of cancer, including colon, breast, ovary and prostate carcinomas. Several potential glycoprotein ligands for galectin-1 have been identified, including lysosome-associated membrane glycoproteins and fibronectin, laminin, as well as T-cell glycoproteins CD43 and CD45.
Predicted N Terminal	Ala 2
Form	Lyophilized from 0.2 μ m filtered solution of PBS, 0.1M β -lactosyl, pH7.4. Normally 5 %-8 % trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization. Specific concentrations are included in the hardcopy of COA.

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Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to agglutinate human red blood cells. The ED50 for this effect is typically 0.5-3 µg/ml.

Endotoxin	< 5 eu per 1 mg of the protein as determined by the lal
Purity	>97 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Stability	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70 °C.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -70°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

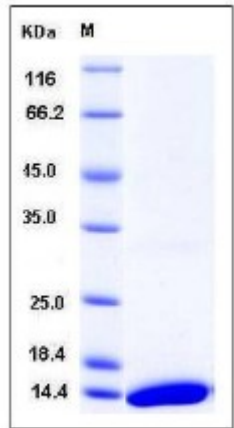
