Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse Parp1 (NP_031441.2) (Met 1-Trp 1014), fused with a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus, was produced in Baculovirus-Insect cells.

Form	Lyophilized from sterile 20mM Tris, 500mM NaCl, pH 8.0, 10% gly, 0.1mM TCEP
Molecular Mass	The recombinant mouse PARP1 consists of 1033 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 115 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 75 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method
Purity	> 85 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
