The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8°C for one month. Aliquot and store at

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-80°C for 12 months.

Storage buffer Supplied as lyophilized form in PBS, pH7.4, containing 5% trehalose, 0.01% sarcosyl.

Reconstitution Reconstitute in sterile PBS, pH7.2-pH7.4.

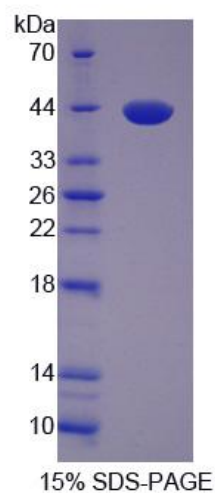
