

Active Recombinant Mouse Cirbp protein, His-tagged

SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse Cirbp protein(1-172 aa) was fused with a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus.
Species	Mouse
ProteinLength	1-172 aa
Form	20mM Tris, 150mM NaCl, pH8.0, containing 1mM EDTA, 1mM DTT, 0.01% SKL, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.
Bio-activity	Cold-inducible RNA-binding protein (CIRBP) plays a critical role in controlling the cellular response upon confronting a variety of cellular stresses, including short wavelength ultraviolet light, hypoxia, and hypothermia. Besides, Heterogeneous Nuclear Ribonucleoprotein A1 (HNRPA1) has been identified as an interactor of CIRBP, thus a binding ELISA assay was conducted to detect the interaction of recombinant mouse CIRBP and recombinant mouse HNRPA1. Briefly, CIRBP were diluted serially in PBS, with 0.01% BSA (pH 7.4). Duplicate samples of 100μL were then transferred to HNRPA1-coated microtiter wells and incubated for 2h at 37°C. Wells were washed with PBST and incubated for 1h with anti-CIRBP pAb, then aspirated and washed 3 times. After incubation with HRP labelled secondary antibody, wells were aspirated and washed 3 times. With the addition of substrate solution, wells were incubated 15-25 minutes at 37°C. Finally, add 50μ stop solution to the wells and read at 450nm immediately. The binding activity of CIRBP and HNRPA1 was shown, and this effect was in a dose dependent manner.

Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at -20°C for 12 months. Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in 20mM Tris, 150mM NaCl (pH8.0) to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Do not vortex.

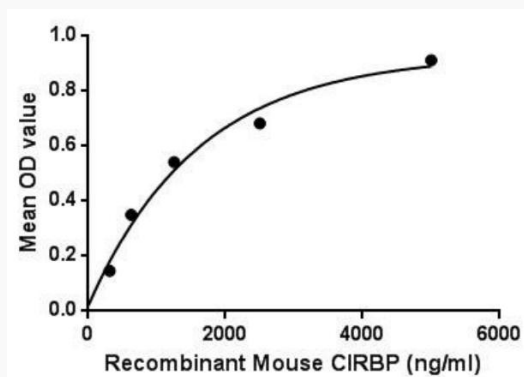

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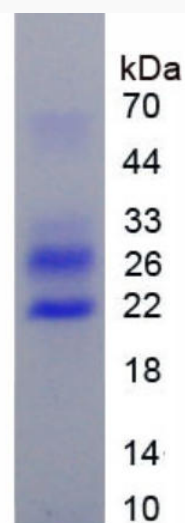
