Product Overview	Recombinant Human VSIR protein (Phe33-Ala194), fused to human IgG1 Fc tag at C-terminus, was expressed in human 293 cells (HEK293).

Description	Platelet receptor Gi24, also known as B7-H5 and stress-induced secreted protein-1 (Sisp-1), is a protein that in humans is encoded by the C10orf54 gene, which contains 1 Ig-like (immunoglobulin-like) domain. As for C10orf54 gene, C10orf54 appears to positively interact with BMP-4, potentiating BMP signaling and the transition from an undifferentiated to a differentiated state on ESCs. Human C10orf54 undergoes proteolytic cleavage by MT1-MMP, generating a soluble 30 kDa extracellular fragment plus a 25-30 kDa membrane-bound fragment.
Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 um filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4, 10% trehalose.
Molecular Mass	The protein has a calculated MW of 44.8 kDa. The protein migrates as 55-60 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to Glycosylation.
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per ug by the LAL method.
Purity	>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

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Storage

For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20 centigrade or lower.

Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

This product is stable after storage at:

- 20 centigrade to -70 centigrade for 12 months in lyophilized state;
- 70 centigrade for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.

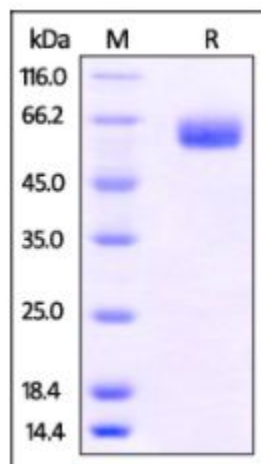

Human B7-H5, Fc Tag on SDS-PAGE under reducing (R) condition. The gel was stained overnight with Coomassie Blue. The purity of the protein is greater than 95%.
