Product Overview	Recombinant human CSF2 was expressed in E. coli and purified by conventional chromatography, after refolding of the isolated inclusion bodies in a renaturation buffer. MW: 14.6 kDa.

Description	Human CSF2 is a 14.6 kDa globular protein consisting of 128 amino acid containing two disulfide bonds. CSF2 is a hematopoietic growth factor that stimulates the development of neutrophils and macrophages and promotes the proliferation and development of early erythroid megakaryocytic and eosinophilic progenitor cells.
Form	Liquid in phosphate-buffered saline (pH 7.4).
Bio-activity	The ED50 for this effect is < 0.18 ng/ml, measured in a cell proliferation assay using tf1 human erythroleukemic cells.
Molecular Mass	14.6 kDa (128 aa), confirmed by MALDI-TOF.
