Product Overview	Recombinant mouse EPHB1 (591-end) was expressed by baculovirus in Sf9 insect cells using a N-terminal GST tag.

Description	EPHB1 is a member of the Eph family of receptor tyrosine kinases. Ligand-activated EPHB1 forms a signaling complex with Nck, paxillin, and focal adhesion kinase and induces tyrosine phosphorylation of paxillin in a c-Src-dependent manner to promote cell migration. In addition, activated EPHB1 recruits the adaptor proteins Grb2 and p52Shc and promotes p52Shc and c-Src tyrosine phosphorylation as well as MAPK/extracellular signal-regulated kinase (ERK) activation. Expression of dominant-negative c-Src significantly reduced EPHB1-dependent ERK1/2 activation and chemotaxis.
Form	Recombinant protein stored in 50mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.5, 150mM NaCl, 0.25mM DTT, 0.1mM EGTA, 0.1mM EDTA, 0.1mM PMSF, 25% glycerol.
