Product Overview	Biotinylated Recombinant Human IL15 protein(Asn 49 - Ser 162), fused with Fc and Avi tag, was expressed in HEK293.

Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in Tris with Glycine, Arginine and NaCl, pH7.5. Normally trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Human IL-15 R alpha, Fc Tag at 2 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind Biotinylated Human IL-15, Fc,Avitag with a linear range of 0.5-8 ng/mL.
Molecular Mass	This protein carries a human IgG1 Fc tag at the C-terminus, followed by an Avi tag (Avitag™).The protein has a calculated MW of 41.0 kDa. The protein migrates as 54-60 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.
Proteinlength	Asn49-Ser162
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.>90% as determined by SEC-MALS.

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Storage	For long term, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. This product is stable after at: -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
