Product Overview	Recombinant full-length human CDKN3 was expressed by baculovirus in Sf9 insect cells using an N-terminal GST tag.

Description	CDKN3 is a member of the dual specificity protein phosphatase family that acts as a cyclin-dependent kinase inhibitor. CDKN3 has been shown to interact with and dephosphorylate specifically the CDK2 kinase thereby preventing it's activation. CDKN3 has been reported to be deleted, mutated, or overexpressed in several kinds of cancers. Increased expression of CDKN3 leads to increased levels of kinase-associated phosphatase activity that inhibits the G(1)/S transition of the cell cycle by dephosphorylating the cyclin-dependent kinases.
Form	Recombinant protein stored in 50mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.5, 150mM NaCl, 10mM glutathione, 0.1mM EDTA, 0.25mM DTT, 0.1mM PMSF, 25% glycerol.

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Storage	Store at –70°C. For optimal storage, aliquot target into smaller quantities after centrifugation and store at recommended temperature. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
