Product Overview	Recombinant Human BTLA protein (Lys31-Ser150), fused to His tag at C-terminus, was expressed in human 293 cells (HEK293).

Description	B- and T-lymphocyte attenuator (BTLA) is also known as B- and T-lymphocyte-associated protein, CD antigen CD272. BTLA contains one Ig-like V-type (immunoglobulin-like) domain. As a lymphocyte inhibitory receptor, BTLA/CD272 inhibits lymphocytes during immune response. BTLA/CD272 can interact with tyrosine phosphatases PTPN6/SHP-1 and PTPN11/SHP-2, and interact with TNFRSF14/HVEM.
Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 um filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4, 10% trehalose.
Molecular Mass	The protein has a calculated MW of 15.6 kDa. The protein migrates as 25-40 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per ug by the LAL method.
Purity	>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

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Storage

For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20 centigrade or lower.

Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

This product is stable after storage at:

- 20 centigrade to -70 centigrade for 12 months in lyophilized state;
- 70 centigrade for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.

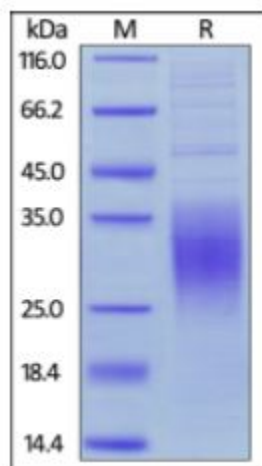
