May play a role in the establishment of contextual mory, probably via the dephosphorylation of proteins that are part of important signaling cascades. |

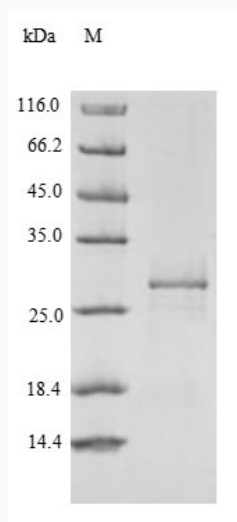
