Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse TFAP2A Protein (1-437 aa) is produced by E. coli expression system. This protein is fused with a 10xHis tag at the N-terminal and a Myc tag at the C-terminal. Research Area: Epigenetics and Nuclear Signaling. Protein Description: Full Length.

Description	Sequence-specific DNA-binding protein that interacts with inducible viral and cellular enhancer elements to regulate transcription of selected genes. AP-2 factors bind to the consensus sequence 5'-GCCNNNGGC-3' and activate genes involved in a large spectrum of important biological functions including proper eye, face, body wall, limb and neural tube development. They also suppress a number of genes including MCAM/MUC18, C/EBP alpha and MYC. AP-2-alpha is the only AP-2 protein required for early morphogenesis of the lens vesicle. Together with the CITED2 coactivator, stimulates the PITX2 P1 promoter transcription activation. Associates with chromatin to the PITX2 P1 promoter region.

Notes	Repeated freezing and thawing is not recommended. Store working aliquots at 4 centigrade for up to one week.
Storage	The shelf life is related to many factors, storage state, buffer ingredients, storage temperature and the stability of the protein itself. Generally, the shelf life of liquid form is 6 months at -20 centigrade/-80 centigrade. The shelf life of lyophilized form is 12 months at -20 centigrade/-80 centigrade.

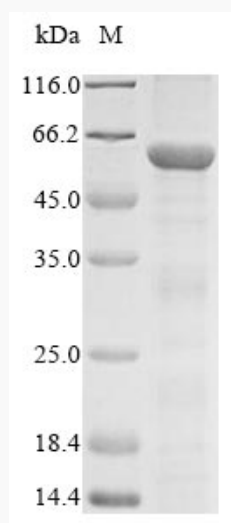
