Product Overview	Recombinant Human PDE1C protein(Q8TAE4) (Met1-Glu634) was expressed in Insect Cells, fused with the N-terminal polyhistidine-tagged GST tag at the N-terminus.

Source	Insect Cells
ProteinLength	1-634 aa
Form	Lyophilized from sterile 20mM Tris, 500mM NaCl, pH 7.4, 10% gly, 3mM DTT
Molecular Mass	The recombinant human PDE1C /GST chimera consists of 871 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 100 kDa. The recombinant protein migrates as an approximately 97 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method
Purity	> 85 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C upon receiving. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of

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0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
