Product Overview	Recombinant Phosphatase-1 Catalytic Subunit, α -Isoform from rabbit without tag was expressed in E.coli.

Description	Protein phosphatase1 (PP1) is a heterodimeric enzyme with serine/threonine phosphatase activity. It comprises a catalytic subunit and a targeting subunit or a specific protein inhibitor. The targeting subunit determines the enzyme localization, e.g., to glycogen particles (subunit G) or to myofibrils (subunit M). Protein phosphatase1 (PP1) is involved in glycogen metabolism and in regulation of muscle contractility. In addition, it is implicated in cell cycle and transcriptional regulation. Recombinant rabbit PP1α has properties in common with the native rabbit muscle protein including size, requirement for Mn²⁺ for activity, specificity for phosphorylase A, and inhibition by okadaic acid, microcystin LR, and phosphatase inhibitor2 (I-2).

Lyophilized powder containing imidazole buffer, pH 7.4, NaCl, DTT, EDTA, MnCl₂, Tween 20, and trehalose as stabilizer.

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
