Product Overview	Recombinant protein of human Duffy blood group, chemokine receptor (DARC), transcript variant 2 with C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, expressed in HEK293T cells.
Species	Human
Source	HEK293
Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a glycosylated membrane protein and a non-specific receptor for several chemokines. The encoded protein is the receptor for the human malarial parasites <i>Plasmodium vivax</i> and <i>Plasmodium knowlesi</i> . Polymorphisms in this gene are the basis of the Duffy blood group system. Two transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.

Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Stability	Stable for 12 months from the date of receipt of the product under proper storage and handling conditions. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage	Store at -80 centigrade.
Concentration	>50 µg/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
Storage Buffer	25 mM Tris.HCl, pH 7.3, 100 mM glycine, 10% glycerol

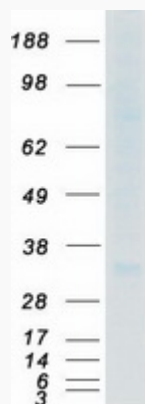
