Product Overview	Native bee venom sPLA2 protein without tag was isolated from Bee venom.

Description	PLA2 catalyzes the hydrolysis of fatty acids at the sn-2 position of glycerophospholipids, yielding a free fatty acid and a lysophospholipid. The extracellular or secretory PLA2 obtained from snake or bee venom, mammalian pancreas, or human synovial fluid are small, 14 kDa proteins which are dependent on Ca ²⁺ for catalytic activity and can hydrolyze any fatty acid at the sn-2 position.

Unit Definition	One unit of enzyme hydrolyzes one μ mol of Diheptanoyl Thio-PC per minute at 25 centigrade.
