Product Overview	Recombinant Human LILRB3 protein(O75022-1)(Gly24-Glu443), fused with C-terminal His and Avi tag, was expressed in HEK293.

Form	Lyophilized from 0.22µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 5% trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Human LILRB3, His Tag at 5µg/ml (100µl/well) on the plate. Dose response curve for Anti-LILRB3 Antibody, hFc Tag with the EC50 of 12.5ng/ml determined by ELISA.
Molecular Mass	The protein has a predicted MW of 50 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 60-72 kDa based on Tris-Bis PAGE result.
Endotoxin	Less than 1EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95% as determined by Tris-Bis PAGE; > 95% as determined by HPLC

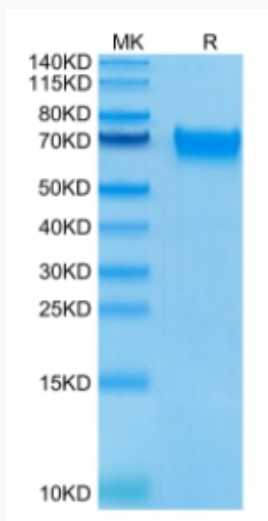

Storage	Reconstituted protein stable at -80°C for 12 months, 4°C for 1 week. Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	Centrifuge tubes before opening. Reconstituting to a concentration more than 100 µg/ml is recommended. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water.
