Product Overview	Recombinant human MAOB protein without tag was expressed in insect cells.

Source	Insect cells
Description	The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the flavin monoamine oxidase family. It is a enzyme located in the mitochondrial outer membrane. It catalyzes the oxidative deamination of biogenic and xenobiotic amines and plays an important role in the metabolism of neuroactive and vasoactive amines in the central nervous system and peripheral tissues. This protein preferentially degrades benzylamine and phenylethylamine.
Bio-activity	Activity Data(Unless otherwise stated, all assays are carried out at 37 centigrade in 90 mM potassium phosphate (pH 7.4)) Substrate: Kynuramine (4-hydroxyquinoline formation) Linear with time up to: 30 min(Determined at 20 μM substrate, using a protein concentration of 5 μg/ml) Linear with protein up to: 15 μg/ml (see note 3)(Determined at 20 μM substrate, using an incubation time of 10 min. Under these incubation conditions, the reaction is not strictly linear across the protein concentration range from 2 – 20 μg/ml: measured enzyme activity increases as the protein concentration increases) Vmax: 104 nmol/min/mg protein Km: 53 μM
