Description	Aldehyde oxidase produces hydrogen peroxide and, under certain conditions, can catalyze the formation of superoxide. Aldehyde oxidase is a candidate gene for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis.
Bio-activity	AOX Activity Data(Assays are carried out at 37 centigrade in 25 mM potassium phosphate buffer (pH 7.4) containing 0.1 mM EDTA. The reaction is linear with protein concentration up to 1.0 mg/ml at 10 μ M phthalazine) Substrate: Phthalazine Vmax: 337 pmol/min/mg protein Km: 12 μ M
Usage	For laboratory (research) purposes only
Storage	Store at -80 centigrade. Avoid frequent temperature changes. Thaw on ice.
Concentration	Protein Concentration: 10.0 mg/ml
Storage Buffer	25 mM potassium phosphate (pH 7.4) containing 0.1 mM EDTA

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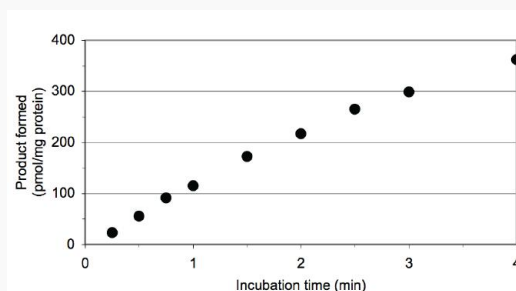
