Alpha 1 acid glycoprotein (orosomucin) (A1AG) is a major serum glycoprotein of unknown physiological function. alpha-1-acid glycoprotein (A1AG) has been implicated in cellular inflammation by increasing tissue factor expression and tumour necrosis factor alpha secretion of monocytes.
