Product Overview	Recombinant protein of human phosphotriesterase related (PTER), transcript variant 1 with C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, expressed in HEK293T cells.

Description	PTER (Phosphotriesterase Related) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with PTER include Chromosome 9P Deletion Syndrome and Nodular Tenosynovitis. Gene Ontology (GO) annotations related to this gene include hydrolase activity, acting on ester bonds and endodeoxyribonuclease activity, producing 5'-phosphomonoesters.

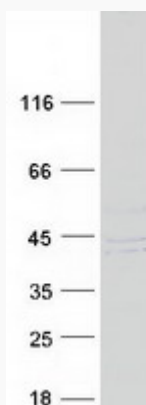
