Product Overview	Recombinant Human EGFR (HER1) Protein (25-645aa), was expressed in mammalian system with C-terminal His tag and Avi tag.

Description	The epidermal growth factor receptor is a transmembrane protein that is a receptor for members of the epidermal growth factor family of extracellular protein ligands. The epidermal growth factor receptor is a member of the ErbB family of receptors, a subfamily of four closely related receptor tyrosine kinases: EGFR, HER2/neu, Her 3 and Her 4. Receptor tyrosine kinase binding ligands of the EGF family and activating several signaling cascades to convert extracellular cues into appropriate cellular responses.
Form	Supplied as 0.22um filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4).
Molecular Mass	The protein has a predicted MW of 71.5 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 85-110KDa based on Bis-Tris PAGE result.
Endotoxin	Less than 0.05EU per ug by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95% as determined by SDS-PAGE; > 95% as determined by HPLC

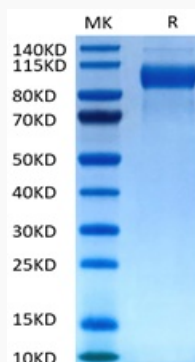
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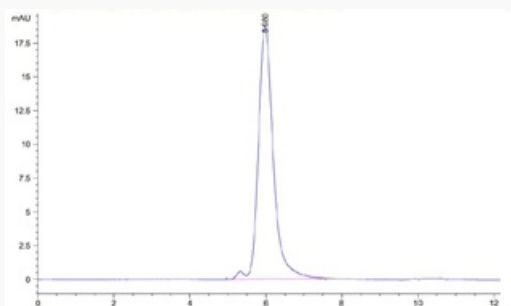

Storage	The product should be stored at -70°C. Please do not repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.

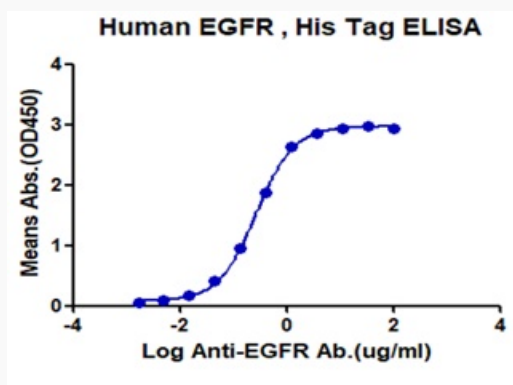
