Product Overview	Recombinant Human CD80 protein(P33681-1)(Val35-Asn242), fused with C-terminal His and Avi tag, was expressed in HEK293.

ProteinLength	Val35-Asn242
Tag	C-His-Avi
Form	Lyophilized from 0.22µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 5% trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Bio-activity	Immobilized Human CTLA-4, hFc Tag at 1µg/ml (100µl/well) on the plate. Dose response curve for Human B7-1, His Tag with the EC50 of 1.48µg/ml determined by ELISA.
Molecular Mass	The protein has a predicted MW of 26.8 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 50-70 kDa based on Tris-Bis PAGE result.
Endotoxin	Less than 1EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95% as determined by Tris-Bis PAGE; > 95% as determined by HPLC

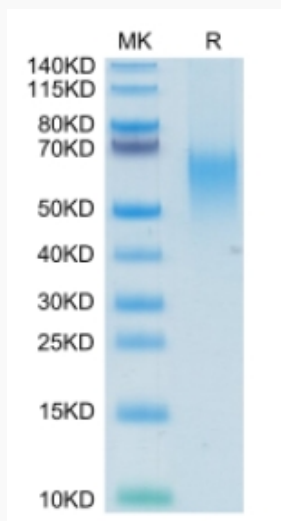
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Storage	Reconstituted protein stable at -80°C for 12 months, 4°C for 1 week. Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	Centrifuge tubes before opening. Reconstituting to a concentration more than 100 µg/ml is recommended. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water.
