Description	Transforming growth factor-beta 2 (TGF-β2) is a secreted protein known as a potent cytokine that modulates embryonic development, bone formation, mammary development, wound healing, hematopoiesis, cell cycle progression and the production of the extracellular matrix.
Bio-activity	The biological activity of Human Transforming Growth Factor-Beta 2 is determined by its ability to inhibit the mouse IL-4-dependent proliferation of mouse HT-2 cells. The ED50 was found to be 5 x 10 ⁶ units/mg.

Storage	The lyophilized protein should be stored desiccated at -20°C. The reconstituted protein can be stored for at least one week at 4°C. For long-term storage of the

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reconstituted protein, aliquot into working volumes and store at -20°C in a manual defrost freezer. Avoid Repeated Freeze Thaw Cycles.
