SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	LCAT Human Recombinant produced in HEK is a single, glycosylated, polypeptide chain containing 429 amino acids (25-440) which includes 13 amino acid Flag Tag fused at N-terminus and having total molecular mass of 48.5 kDa. LCAT Human Recombinant is purified by chromatographic techniques.

Description	This gene encodes the extracellular cholesterol esterifying enzyme, lecithin-cholesterol acyltransferase. The esterification of cholesterol is required for cholesterol transport. Mutations in this gene have been found to cause fish-eye disease as well as LCAT deficiency.
Form	The LCAT protein was lyophilized from 0.4 um filtered solution at concentration of 0.5mg/ml containing 20 mM Tris buffer, and 50mM NaCl, pH 7.5.

Storage

Lyophilized LCAT although stable at room temperature for weeks, should be stored desiccated below -18 °C. Upon reconstitution LCAT should be stored at 4 °C between 2-7 days and for future use below -18 °C. For long term storage it is recommended to add carrier.

Reconstitution

It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized Rat Carboxypeptidase-B in sterile H₂O not less than 100 µg/ml, which can then be further diluted to other aqueous solutions.
