Product Overview	DPH3 MS Standard C13 and N15-labeled recombinant protein (NP_996662) with a C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, was expressed in HEK293 cells.

Description	This gene encodes a CSL zinc finger-containing protein that is required for diphthamide biosynthesis. The encoded protein is necessary for the initial step in the modification of a histidine residue in elongation factor-2 to diphthamide. This modified residue is a target for ADP ribosylation by the bacterial toxins diphtheria toxin and Pseudomonas exotoxin A. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants that encode the same isoform.

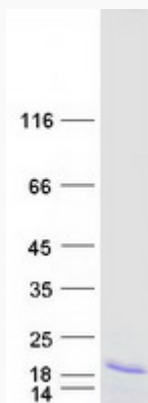
