Among its related pathways are NOD-like receptor signaling pathway. Gene Ontology (GO) annotations related to this gene include cysteine-type endopeptidase inhibitor activity. An important paralog of this gene is CASP1.

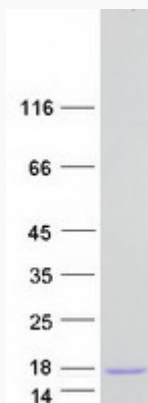
