SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Recombinant chicken α -Spectrin domain SH3 (Spectrin, non-erythroid alpha chain, Fodrin alpha chain) cloned from cDNA from chicken was expressed in <i>E. coli</i> . It consists of the soluble SH3 domain of α -Spectrin from <i>Gallus gallus</i> (residues 965-1025). Swissprot accession P07751. MW = 7.2 kDa.

Description	Spectrin alpha chain, brain is a protein that in humans is encoded by the SPTAN1 gene. The spectrins are a family of widely-distributed cytoskeletal proteins which are involved in actin crosslinking. The protein encoded by this gene is an spectrin alpha-chain which heterodimerizes with tissue-specific beta-chains.
Purity	> 95% by SDS-PAGE. The protein was observed as a single band migrating at molecular weight of <10 kDa.
Supplied As	1.0mg/ml in 50mM Ammonium Acetate, pH 4.5. The concentration is calculated from the absorbance at 280nm ($e_{280} = 15470 \text{ M}^{-1} \text{ cm}^{-1}$).
Characteristics	Under the above described conditions, the product has been concentrated up to 2mM without observing significant precipitation and/or protein aggregation.

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Storage

-20°C. The protein is stable at 4°C for at least 2 weeks and at 25°C for at least several hours. After initial defrost, aliquot product into individual tubes and refreeze at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/defrost cycles.

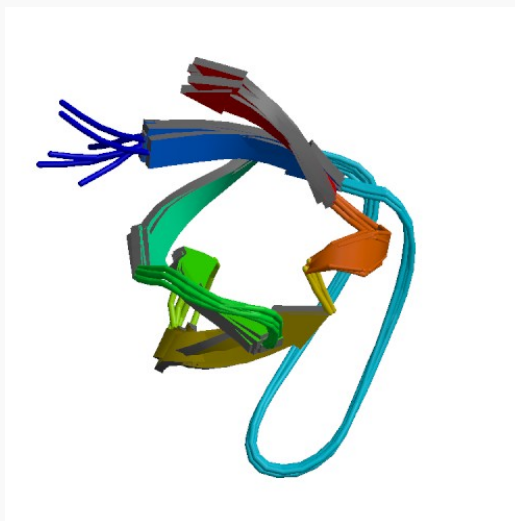
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
