Description	The Mannose Receptor (MR), a member of the vertebrate C-type lectin family, is a pattern recognition receptor that is involved in both innate and adaptive immunity.
Predicted N Terminal	Leu19
Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to bind with Mannan in a functional ELISA.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant Mouse Mrc1 predicts a molecular mass of 156 kDa (monomer). It migrates as an approximately 180 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 0.10 eu per 1 µg of the protein by the lal
Purity	>90%, by SDS-PAGE

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Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -70°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute at 100 µg/mL in sterile PBS.
