Product Overview	Purified recombinant protein of mouse full-length alkylglycerone phosphate synthase (Agps), with C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, expressed in HEK293T cells.

Description	Catalyzes the exchange of the acyl chain in acyl-dihydroxyacetonephosphate (acyl-D HAP) for a long chain fatty alcohol, yielding the first ether linked intermediate, i.e. alkyl-dihydroxyacetonephosphate (alkyl-DHAP), in the pathway of ether lipid biosynthesis.
Molecular Mass	74.3 kDa
Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Stability	Stable for 12 months from the date of receipt of the product under proper storage and handling conditions. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage	Store at -80 centigrade after receiving vials.
Concentration	>50 µg/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
Storage Buffer	25 mM Tris.HCl, pH 7.3, 100 mM glycine, 10% glycerol.
