Product Overview	Purified recombinant protein of mouse full-length Rho GTPase activating protein 29 (Arhgap29), with C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, expressed in HEK293T cells.

Description	GTPase activator for the Rho-type GTPases by converting them to an inactive GDP-bound state. Has strong activity toward RHOA, and weaker activity toward RAC1 and CDC42. May act as a specific effector of RAP2A to regulate Rho. In concert with RASIP1, suppresses RhoA signaling and dampens ROCK and MYH9 activities in endothelial cells and plays an essential role in blood vessel tubulogenesis.

Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Stability	Stable for 12 months from the date of receipt of the product under proper storage and handling conditions. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage Buffer	25 mM Tris.HCl, pH 7.3, 100 mM glycine, 10% glycerol.
