Product Overview	The extracellular domain of mouse APRIL (aa 98-232) is fused at the N-terminus to mouse ACRP30headless (aa 18-110) and a FLAG-tag.

Description	Tumor necrosis factor ligand superfamily member 13 (TNFSF13) also known as a proliferation-inducing ligand (APRIL) is a protein that in humans is encoded by the TNFSF13 gene. TNFSF13 has also been designated CD256 (cluster of differentiation 256).
Specificity	Binds to human and mouse BCMA and TACI. Does not bind to proteoglycans.
Formulation	Lyophilized. Contains PBS, 0.5% Trehalose.
Purity	≥95% (SDS-PAGE)
Endotoxin	<0.01EU/μg purified protein (LAL test; Lonza).
Concentration	0.1mg/ml after reconstitution.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute with 100μl sterile water.

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Handling Advice	After reconstitution, prepare aliquots and store at -20°C. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles. PBS containing at least 0.1% BSA should be used for further dilutions.
Stability	Stable for at least 6 months after receipt when stored at -20°C.
