Product Overview	Purified recombinant protein of mouse full-length gastrin releasing peptide (Grp), with C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, expressed in HEK293T cells.

Description	This gene encodes a neuropeptide hormone that affects various biological processes such as neuroendocrine regulation, gastrointestinal secretion, nociception, cell proliferation and inflammation. The encoded protein undergoes proteolytic processing to generate multiple mature peptides with biological activity.

Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Stability	Stable for 12 months from the date of receipt of the product under proper storage and handling conditions. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage Buffer	25 mM Tris.HCl, pH 7.3, 100 mM glycine, 10% glycerol.
