Product Overview	Purified recombinant protein of mouse full-length protein kinase C and casein kinase substrate in neurons 2 (Pacsin2), with C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, expressed in HEK293T cells.

Description	Regulates the morphogenesis and endocytosis of caveolae Lipid-binding protein that is able to promote the tubulation of the phosphatidic acid-containing membranes it preferentially binds. Plays a role in intracellular vesicle-mediated transport. Involved in the endocytosis of cell-surface receptors like the EGF receptor, contributing to its internalization in the absence of EGF stimulus.

Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Stability	Stable for 12 months from the date of receipt of the product under proper storage and handling conditions. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
