Product Overview	Purified recombinant protein of mouse full-length phosphatase and tensin homolog (Pten), with C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, expressed in HEK293T cells.

Description	This gene encodes a phosphatase with dual activity against phospholipids and proteins, and acts as a tumor-suppressor. The protein contains four structural domains, a PIP2-binding domain, a catalytic tensin-type phosphatase domain, a C2 tensin-type domain and a PDZ-binding domain. The protein belongs to the protein tyrosine phosphatase family. Deletion of this gene in mice contribute to tumorigenesis in multiple tissues.

Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Stability	Stable for 12 months from the date of receipt of the product under proper storage and handling conditions. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage	Store at -80 centigrade after receiving vials.
Concentration	>50 µg/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
