Product Overview	Purified recombinant protein of mouse full-length protein tyrosine phosphatase, receptor type, A (Ptptra), with C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, expressed in HEK293T cells.

Description	Tyrosine protein phosphatase which is involved in integrin-mediated focal adhesion formation. Following integrin engagement, specifically recruits BCAR3, BCAR1 and CRK to focal adhesions thereby promoting SRC-mediated phosphorylation of BRAC1 and the subsequent activation of PAK and small GTPase RAC1 and CDC42.

Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Stability	Stable for 12 months from the date of receipt of the product under proper storage and handling conditions. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage Buffer	25 mM Tris.HCl, pH 7.3, 100 mM glycine, 10% glycerol.
