Product Overview	Purified recombinant protein of mouse full-length tRNA-histidine guanylyltransferase 1-like (<i>S. cerevisiae</i>) (Thg1l), with C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, expressed in HEK293T cells.

Description	Adds a GMP to the 5'-end of tRNA(His) after transcription and RNase P cleavage. This step is essential for proper recognition of the tRNA and for the fidelity of protein synthesis. Also functions as a guanyl-nucleotide exchange factor/GEF for the MFN1 and MFN2 mitofusins thereby regulating mitochondrial fusion. By regulating both mitochondrial dynamics and bioenergetic function, it contributes to cell survival following oxidative stress.

Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Stability	Stable for 12 months from the date of receipt of the product under proper storage and handling conditions. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage	Store at -80 centigrade after receiving vials.
Concentration	>50 µg/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
