Product Overview	Recombinant Human BAI3 protein, fused to His-tag, was expressed in E.coli and purified by Ni-sepharose.

Description	This p53-target gene encodes a brain-specific angiogenesis inhibitor, a seven-span transmembrane protein, and is thought to be a member of the secretin receptor family. Brain-specific angiogenesis proteins BAI2 and BAI3 are similar to BAI1 in structure, have similar tissue specificities, and may also play a role in angiogenesis.
Storage	The protein is stored in PBS buffer at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
Storage Buffer	1M PBS (58mM Na2HPO4, 17mM NaH2PO4, 68mM NaCl, pH8.) added with 300mM Imidazole and 0.7% Sarcosyl, 15% glycerol.
