ProteinLength	It contains Gly25-Thr305 (HLA-G),Ile21-Met119 (B2M) and RIIPRHLQL peptide design.
Form	Supplied as 0.22um filtered solution in PBS , pH7.4.
Molecular Mass	The protein has a predicted MW of 50.5 kDa.Due to glycosylation, the protein tetramer migrates to 230-260 KDa based on Bis-Tris PAGE result.
Endotoxin	Less than 0.1 EU per ug by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95% as determined by Bis-Tris PAGE; > 95% as determined by HPLC
Storage	The product should be stored at -70°C. Please do not repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.

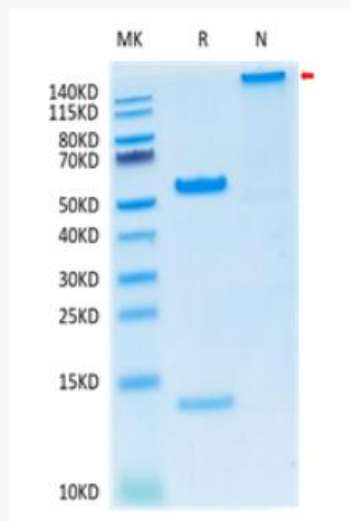

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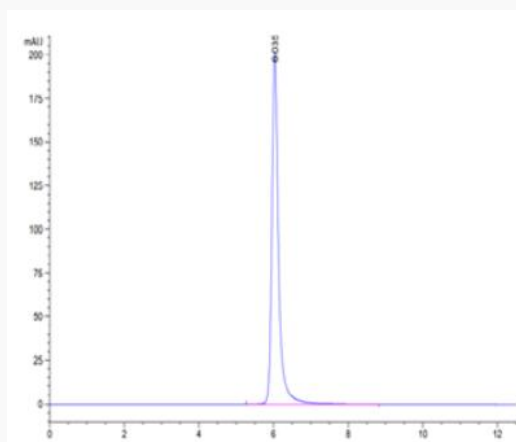
