Product Overview	Recombinant Human BASP1 protein, fused to GST-tag, was expressed in E.coli and purified by GSH-sepharose.

Description	This gene encodes a membrane bound protein with several transient phosphorylation sites and PEST motifs. Conservation of proteins with PEST sequences among different species supports their functional significance. PEST sequences typically occur in proteins with high turnover rates. Immunological characteristics of this protein are species specific. This protein also undergoes N-terminal myristoylation. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants that encode the same protein.
Storage	The protein is stored in PBS buffer at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
Storage Buffer	1M PBS (58mM Na ₂ HPO ₄ , 17mM NaH ₂ PO ₄ , 68mM NaCl, pH8.) added with 100mM GSH and 1% Triton X-100, 15% glycerol.
