Product Overview	Recombinant Human vascular cell adhesion molecule 1(VCAM1) protein, transcript variant 2(NM_080682), with a His tag, was expressed in human cells.

Source	Human Cells
Description	This gene is a member of the Ig superfamily and encodes a cell surface sialoglycoprotein expressed by cytokine-activated endothelium. This type I membrane protein mediates leukocyte-endothelial cell adhesion and signal transduction, and may play a role in the development of arteriosclerosis and rheumatoid arthritis. Three alternatively spliced transcripts encoding different isoforms have been described for this gene.
Form	Purified protein formulated in a sterile solution of TBS buffer, pH7.302, without any preservatives.
Molecular Mass	68.7 kDa
Endotoxin	Endotoxin level is < 0.1 ng/g of protein (<1EU /g)
Purity	>90% by SDS-PAGE gel and Coomassie Blue staining
Applications	Antigens, Western, ELISA and other in vitro binding or in vivo functional assays, and protein-protein interaction studies.
