Product Overview	Recombinant Human natural cytotoxicity triggering receptor 3(NCR3) protein, transcript variant 1(NM_147130), with a His tag, was expressed in human cells.

Source	Human Cells
Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a natural cytotoxicity receptor (NCR) that may aid NK cells in the lysis of tumor cells. The encoded protein interacts with CD3-zeta (CD247), a T-cell receptor. A single nucleotide polymorphism in the 5' untranslated region of this gene has been associated with mild malaria susceptibility. Three transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.
Form	Purified protein formulated in a sterile solution of TBS buffer, pH7.167, without any preservatives.
Molecular Mass	40.2kD
Endotoxin	Endotoxin level is < 0.1 ng/g of protein (<1EU /g)
Purity	>90% by SDS-PAGE gel and Coomassie Blue staining
Applications	Antigens, Western, ELISA and other in vitro binding or in vivo functional assays, and protein-protein interaction studies.
