Product Overview	Recombinant Human interleukin 31 receptor A(IL31RA) protein, transcript variant 1(NM_139017), with a His tag, was expressed in human cells.

Source	Human Cells
Description	The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the type I cytokine receptor family. This receptor, with homology to gp130, is expressed on monocytes, and is involved in IL-31 signaling via activation of STAT-3 and STAT-5. It functions either as a monomer, or as part of a receptor complex with oncostatin M receptor (OSMR). Several alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been noted for this gene.
Form	Purified protein formulated in a sterile solution of TBS buffer, pH7.109, without any preservatives.
Molecular Mass	86.3 kDa
Endotoxin	Endotoxin level is < 0.1 ng/g of protein (<1EU /g)
Purity	>90% by SDS-PAGE gel and Coomassie Blue staining
Applications	Antigens, Western, ELISA and other in vitro binding or in vivo functional assays, and protein-protein interaction studies.
