Product Overview	Recombinant Human CEA cell adhesion molecule 5 (CEACAM5), transcript variant 1(NM_004363), with a DYKDDDDK tag, was expressed in human cells.

Description	This gene encodes a cell surface glycoprotein that represents the founding member of the carcinoembryonic antigen (CEA) family of proteins. The encoded protein is used as a clinical biomarker for gastrointestinal cancers and may promote tumor development through its role as a cell adhesion molecule. Additionally, the encoded protein may regulate differentiation, apoptosis, and cell polarity. This gene is present in a CEA family gene cluster on chromosome 19. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants.
Form	Purified protein formulated in a sterile solution of TBS buffer, pH7.320, without any preservatives.
Molecular Mass	72.8 kDa
Endotoxin	Endotoxin level is < 0.1 ng/g of protein (<1EU /g)
Purity	>90% by SDS-PAGE gel and Coomassie Blue staining
