Product Overview	Recombinant Human CD19 molecule(CD19), transcript variant 2(NM_001770), with a DYKDDDDK tag, was expressed in human cells.

Source	Human Cells
Description	Lymphocytes proliferate and differentiate in response to various concentrations of different antigens. The ability of the B cell to respond in a specific, yet sensitive manner to the various antigens is achieved with the use of low-affinity antigen receptors. This gene encodes a cell surface molecule which assembles with the antigen receptor of B lymphocytes in order to decrease the threshold for antigen receptor-dependent stimulation.
Form	Purified protein formulated in a sterile solution of TBS buffer, pH7.364, without any preservatives.
Molecular Mass	57 kDa
Endotoxin	Endotoxin level is < 0.1 ng/g of protein (<1EU /g)
Purity	>90% by SDS-PAGE gel and Coomassie Blue staining
Applications	Antigens, Western, ELISA and other in vitro binding or in vivo functional assays, and protein-protein interaction studies.
