Product Overview	Recombinant Human CD164 molecule (CD164), transcript variant 1 (NM_006016), with a His tag, was expressed in human cells.
Species	Human
Source	Human Cells
Description	This gene encodes a transmembrane sialomucin and cell adhesion molecule that regulates the proliferation, adhesion and migration of hematopoietic progenitor cells. The encoded protein also interacts with the C-X-C chemokine receptor type 4 and may regulate muscle development. Elevated expression of this gene has been observed in human patients with Sezary syndrome, a type of blood cancer, and a mutation in this gene may be associated with impaired hearing.
Form	Purified protein formulated in a sterile solution of TBS buffer, pH7.242, without any preservatives.
Molecular Mass	20.7 kDa
Endotoxin	Endotoxin level is < 0.1 ng/g of protein (<1EU /g)
Purity	>90% by SDS-PAGE gel and Coomassie Blue staining
Applications	Antigens, Western, ELISA and other in vitro binding or in vivo functional assays, and protein-protein interaction studies.
