Description	This gene encodes a member of the NeuroD family of basic helix-loop-helix (bHLH) transcription factors. The protein forms heterodimers with other bHLH proteins and activates transcription of genes that contain a specific DNA sequence known as the E-box. It regulates expression of the insulin gene, and mutations in this gene result in type II diabetes mellitus.

Storage	Upon arrival, the lyophilized protein may be stored for 2 weeks at 4 centigrade. For

long term storage, it is recommended to store desiccated below -20 centigrade in a manual defrost freezer. Following reconstitution, the protein may be stored for 2 weeks under sterile conditions at -20 centigrade. For long term storage, it is recommended to make appropriate aliquots and store at -80 centigrade. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage Buffer Lyophilized from a 0.45 µm filtered solution in 1x PBS (pH 7.4).

Reconstitution Briefly spin the vial and bring the contents to the bottom prior to opening. It is recommended to reconstitute at 0.5~1.0 mg/mL with sterile deionized water.

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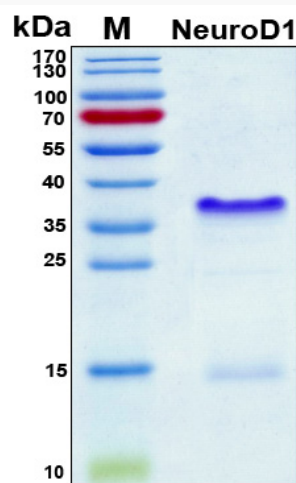
