Product Overview	Recombinant human full-length USP1 was expressed by baculovirus in Sf9 insect cells using an N-terminal GST tag.

Source	Insect Cells
Description	This gene encodes a member of the ubiquitin-specific processing (UBP) family of proteases that is a deubiquitinating enzyme (DUB) with His and Cys domains. This protein is located in the cytoplasm and cleaves the ubiquitin moiety from ubiquitin-fused precursors and ubiquitinated proteins. The protein specifically deubiquitinates a protein in the Fanconi anemia (FA) DNA repair pathway. Alternate transcriptional splice variants have been characterized.
Molecular Mass	Approx 130 kDa
Purity	> 75%
Stability	One year at -70 centigrade from data of shipment.
Storage	Store product at -70 centigrade. For optimal storage, aliquot target into smaller quantities after centrifugation and store at recommended temperature. For most favorable performance, avoid repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw cycles.

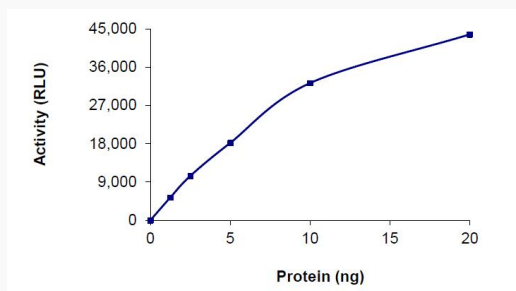

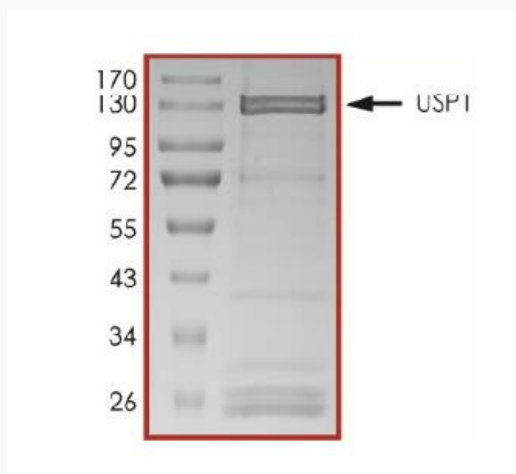
